Translucent Flowers Sampler



Translucent flowers stamp set and dies

Cardstock: Basic White, Lost Lagoon or your preferred colour choice.

Vellum Gold Foil

Ink Colours- your preferred choice

Versamark

Gold Embosssing Powder

15cm (approx.) of Natural Wavy trim

Brushed Metallic Gold dots

6" x 6" frame

Hint: Cutting everything first is a good idea and then put it together.

Preparation:

Colour a piece of Vellum with your preferred colour using a blending brush in a foliage colour and the colour you wish your flowers to be.

Cut these out using the dies.

Cut extra leaves out in Basic White cardstock and blend these with your chosen colour.

Cut some gold foil sprigs and centres for your flowers as well.

Cut a piece of Lost Lagoon (or your chosen colour) for the base $6" \times 6"$ (15.2 x 15.2cm)

Cut a piece of Basic White 12.5cm square. Emboss this with the Timeworn Embossing Folder. At this point you can add some highlighting on the Basic White layer to make the embossing stand out more.

Adhere the Basic White layer to the Base layer.

Floral arrangement.

Glue the Natural Wavy trim to the left side and bottom of the base. This will be where you place your floral arrangement.

Make up flowers using glue dots.

Arrange the flowers in a pleasing way along the trim. You may want to raise some on dimensionals. Tuck foliage under these.

When you are happy with your arrangement you can begin to glue them in place.

For Sentiment:

Stamp in Versamark and emboss in gold. Cut out using one of the flower dies. You can highlight the edges if you wish with ink.

Place on base with dimensionals and then add some brushed metallic dots.
